Conditions of entry

Photography

- No more than one photography entry per student (or group of students) currently attending school.
- Students' photographs can be processed and manipulated either in a dark room or digitally.
- Entries can be in colour or black and white.
- All photographs to be submitted in a digital format only. No hard copies required.
- Digital format photographs must be a minimum of 2mb or 300dpi. Images outside these sizes will not be accepted.
- Photographs entered may be used by Council in promoting the Youth Photographic Award and Short Film Prize and related council activities.

Short Film

- Only one film / animation entry per student (or group of students) currently attending school.
- Films must not exceed 5 minutes in length, inclusive of titles, credits and school to be shown (acknowledging any copyright).
- The film must be made in the last 18 months and may be produced by more than one person.
- Films entered may be used by Council in promoting the Youth Photographic Award and Short Film Prize and related council activities.
- Films must be submitted as MP4 file on DVD, USB or via file sharing service (eg. Dropbox, WeTransfer, Google Drive). Please note, video files **must not** be emailed directly.

Who can enter?

Any secondary student attending school in Woollahra or nearby areas or who lives in the Woollahra Municipality.
